The Heart & Vascular Hospital - The newly-opened Heart & Vascular Hospital, 495 Medical Center Boulevard, expands Clear Lake Regional Medical Center's space by 225,000 square feet, and includes:

- Three cardiovascular (CV) operating rooms
- Four catheterization labs
- A 23-bed pre- and post-recovery area for catheterization lab and OR patients
- An eight-bed Cardiovascular Critical Care unit
- 60 private inpatient telemetry rooms
- A 14-bed Coronary Care Unit

- Areas for Cardiac Rehab, Echocardiogram, EKG and Nuclear Medicine
- A second-story pedestrian skywalk connects the two medical towers
