Some of Staples' career highlights include receiving the 2003 NASA Public Service Medal for exceptional contributions to the mission of NASA, serving as the chairman of the board for the Bay Area Houston Economic Partnership in 2003 and 2004, receiving the Texas Art Education Association's 2004 Governmental Award for Meritorious Service in the Arts, and being selected as the 2005 E. A. Smith YMCA Community of Stars Gala honoree.
