Cultivating Compassion with New Patient Care Program

To help lift patients' spirits, San Jacinto Methodist Hospital recently implemented the Adventures in Caring program. Under the program, hospital employees volunteer to be the Raggedy Ann and Andy characters and visit with patients that are in need of friendly conversation.

Prior to visiting with patients, the Adventures in Caring volunteers complete a 30 hour training session on therapeutic listening skills. Raggedy Volunteers learn how to convey four life-affirming messages to patients and their families: attention, acknowledgment, affection and acceptance. In addition the Adventures in Caring volunteers work closely with nursing staff to help them choose which patients to visit. These visits should bring comfort, encouragement, and joy to those patients who might otherwise have no visitors.
